Dear Parent/Carers,

**Re: Year 11 Covid School Partial Closure**

I am writing to each year group to explain the current situation in your child's year group and layout the plans for the next two weeks.

As you are already aware we have experienced a large number of Coronavirus cases during the last week. With each positive result we have also identified a number of staff and students who are considered to be close contacts. These close contacts have to isolate for 14 days from the last contact that they had with the person who tested positive. As a large number of staff have either tested positive or are classed as a close contact we do not have the appropriate staff ratios to run our normal face to face education.

The situation in Year 11 is that 3 children and a number of teachers have now tested positive for Coronavirus. These cases have been relatively isolated, resulting in us being able to continue with face to face to education for those children who are able to attend. Next week we are expecting two-year groups back into school after a period of isolation. This means we will not have the appropriate staffing ratios. For this reason, we will require Year 11 to work from home on the following dates:

**Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> November, Friday 27<sup>th</sup> November and Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November.**

If your child is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or is a close or household contact with somebody with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, they must stay at home as per the national guidelines.

The current plan is that all Year 11 students are due to **return to school on Tuesday 1st December.** This date coincides with a large number of Year 11 students finishing their period of self-isolation. Please note that if positive cases increase further before this time it may be necessary for Year to self-isolate/work from home sooner than Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> November.

**If your child's period of self-isolation ends AFTER this date it is imperative they continue to self-isolate until the 14 days is finished.**

Please note that we have a staff INSET day on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December. Children must stay at home on this day.
