


☐ FLat notes are to the Left ☐


Every sharp note can be referred to by another name, a flat.


This is called an enharmonic equivalent.

HAND POSITION

Hand position is very important in our keyboard playing. It helps us to play more fluently, prevents injury and builds towards strong muscle memory.






Adding a dot to a note, makes it half as long again.

A crotchet = 1 so a dotted crotchet = 1.5

A minim = 2 so a dotted minim = $3 \int_{\bullet}^{\bullet}$
