



Dear Parents and Carers

As we continue to work together to achieve the best outcomes possible for our students, please consider the following information and guidance.

Revisions sessions are planned and provided in Academy times 8.00am to 2.50pm around examination times with Teachers of each subject. The Exam Timetable and Revision Timetable is available on Twitter and on our Website, please check these regularly so that you are aware of what is happening for your child on a daily basis. If your child attends a Revision session at 8.00am, there is breakfast available in our canteen.

Students must attend exams, even if they feel unwell. Only if an exam is attempted can special considerations be applied. If a student does not attend, no special consideration can be given. If a student was isolating due to COVID (isolation periods for children are 3 days), the email confirmation of the positive test result must be made available to us. The student must sit one of the papers for the subject to qualify for special considerations.

Students are required to write in black pen (not gel pen) and if they bring water, the bottle must not have a label on it. Mobile phones and watches of any description should not be brought into the examination for any reason. If possible, these should be left at home.

Results day is Thursday 25th August 2022 and further details about this will be sent in due course.
