**Dear Families** 

We have almost reached the end of a very busy half term at the Academy. As we reflect on the successes and challenges of this year, I would like to thank you personally for all your support and good wishes. Our staff continue to work tirelessly to encourage our students to live out our values of pride, ambition, and respect. ### Arrangements for the last day of term

As previously communicated, students will finish for summer on Friday 21 July at 12:00 p.m. Year groups will be slightly staggered to allow for a smooth exit from the Academy.

Students will have the opportunity for 'brunch' at breaktime in place of a formal lunch. Students who are entitled to a free school meal can access it at this point.

## Uniform standards for September

When students return to the Academy on Monday 4th September, we expect that the basic expectations of uniform will be met by all. This means: It is compulsory for all students to wear full school uniform including a blazer, tie, and school shoes. Correct black footwear - no trainers at all, including 'on cloud' trainers.

We have listened to student feedback about clip on ties, and from September will be offering traditional ties instead. We now have a stock of new and used uniform for any student/family who needs it. For students who come to school without the correct uniform, they will be provided with the missing items such as shoes, blazer, or tie. For those that consistently refuse to cooperate with basic rules over clothing (for example coats) they will be placed on daily detentions and parents will be invited into school to discuss how we can rectify the matter. If you are struggling to provide the correct uniform, please contact the office because we may be able to assist you.

We will be running further uniform Swap Shops on GCSE results day, Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August between 11am and 12pm and Friday 1<sup>st</sup> September between 2pm and 4pm.

All students will be issued with their own locker in September near to their form room. Keys will be given out on the first day.

As usual at the start of a new year, there have been lots of changes to the teaching classes that students have been placed in. There is a variety of reasons for these changes such as staffing, students' attitude to learning and their progress. If you have any concerns with any of your child's new classes, please contact the relevant Head of Year.

# Year 11 Results Day August 2023

School will be open from 8.30am – 12pm on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August. All students will arrive via the main entrance where they will collect their results from a member of staff, who will be offering support with enrolment to Sixth Form or college.

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## Attendance #2daysorless #everydaycounts

High expectations will continue to be set for all students with regards to attendance from September 2023. The academy will work closely with parents to maximise attendance and ensure that curriculum time is not missed. Persistent absence will be challenged, and parents will be expected to provide medical evidence when attendance does not meet expectations. Medical and dental appointments should be booked outside of school hours wherever possible, and holidays will not be authorised in term time.

The table below indicates how much learning time is lost per school year when students are absent from school. This is linked closely to academic achievement and future success. Please ensure that you are prepared for when your child starts back in September, know their start date, and have their uniform and equipment ready. If for any reason you are struggling with this, then please contact school before your child is due to return.
